Attendance	See that their child attends school, on time and that the school is informed about absence in a timely manner. Understand that, if illness absence totals more than 10 sessions, medical evidence may be requested	Promote good attendance and punctuality and work with parents to overcome barriers to this. Review whether medical evidence should be requested for children whose illness totals more than 9 sessions	Attend school regularly, arrive on time and be prepared for their learning
Raising concerns/ safeguarding	In a respectful manner, let school know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour. Work with the school and any outside agencies for the interests of my child	In a professional manner, let parents know about any concerns or problems that may affect their child's work or behaviour	Talk to an adult about any problems and, where appropriate be involved in the restorative process to find a resolution
Behaviour, Dress and Policies	Support and adhere to the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour and dress	Promote and celebrate high expectations of learning and behaviour and promote values which reject bullying behaviours and promote inclusive, co-operative behaviour	Behave well, work hard and wear school uniform and keep the school rules
Achievement	Encourage a positive attitude to school work and support my child to complete their homework  Attend Parents' Meetings and discussions about my child's progress	Set realistic amounts of homework, praising those who make good attempts to complete it  Arrange Parent's Meetings during which progress will be discussed	Work hard to do their best and complete homework
Communication	Get to know about my child's life at school and attend special events where possible	Keep parents informed about school activities through regular newsletters home and notices about special events	Talk to my parents about my life at school and keep them informed of what I am currently learning
Respect	Encourage my child to respect others, including through online platforms, and the school environment	Encourage children to respect others, including through their online interactions, and the school environment	Treat others, including through online platforms, and the school environment with respect
