Design and make a model of the Eiffel Tower. This could be made from Lego, straws or even spaghetti and marshmallows to act like glue!

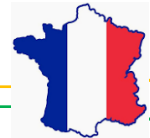


Carry out research about the Eiffel Tower. Who designed it? When was it made? Why was it made? How long did it take to make?
