Interview different generations of your family

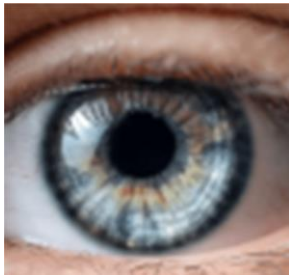
Did your family have the same or different toys that you play with today? You could ask parents and grandparents as well as your siblings.
