Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been able to arrange a day trip to Stubbington Study Centre's recently built Anglo-Saxon Longhouse next Friday.

During the morning, the children will learn more about the everyday lives of the Anglo-Saxons which links closely to our work in our history lessons. In the afternoon, we will be undertaking an additional activity in the conservation area of the centre focusing on our mapping skills.

The day costs £11.00, to be paid through Arbor. In order to reduce costs, please could your child be **dropped off at Stubbington Study Centre at 9.15am and picked up at 2:45pm.**

We will be spending the majority of our time outside and in the longhouse so please can the children dress in warm layers. School uniform is not required. Children must have a coat, ideally waterproof, and we suggest that they also have gloves, hat etc. Please could the children wear trainers. If you wish, they may bring wellies in a named carrier bag as we could get muddy when in the conservation area!

The children will also need to bring a filled water bottle and a packed lunch. Children who are entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch will be provided, only need to supply a filled water bottle.

We look forward to our trip and are sure the children will find it fun as well as educational.
