Projects will be due – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2026

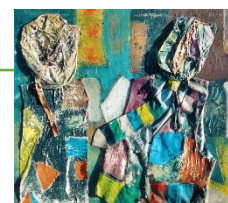
All completed projects will earn house points and will be on display and shared.

#### Art



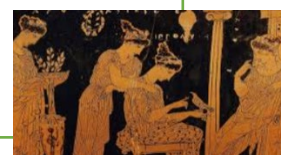
Create a mixed media artwork around the theme 'Groundbreaking Greeks' using recycled materials. Try learning to sew to add an extra element to your art.
